HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

This little guidebook is designed for group use during the Spring of 2023 at Christ the King Anglican Church. It tracks with our E&F series on the Psalms. Each week follows the same basic, four-fold pattern.



READ

Begin by reading the passage.

REFLECT

Deeply reflect on the meaning of the text and respond faithfully.

PRAY



Pray that the Lord would reveal his character to you through this passage. Ask Him to show you how you should respond.



A P P LY

We have not appropriately responded to God's Word until we have refleced on it, prayed it, and then acted upon it. Towards the end of your time, write down one concrete action that you hope to take in the coming week in response to what you've read, discussed, and prayed.



READ

Psalm 133: 1-4

REFLECT

- What perspective is this passage coming from?
- What is the Psalmist communicating to God?
- What do you think God is communicating to you?
- How can this passage be applied to your life? How will you respond?

PRAY



Pray that the Lord would reveal his character to you through this passage. Ask Him to show you how you should respond.

APPLY

How can you apply what you've learned to your life?
